# Rules for Snow Tubing

## High Braes Refuge, Inc.

1. Supervision by High Braes Refuge staff is **required** for use of all tube runs. Runs are not to be used unless Braes personnel are present at the run.
2. After sunset tubing is only allowed on the lighted tube runs. Lights must be on before tubing.
3. Do not walk up the tube runs. Walk up the hill where designated.
4. One person to a tube maximum.
5. The length of tube trains will be determined by Braes staff. Trains will begin with the heaviest person at the front graduating to the lightest person at the rear.
6. Train size may be limited depending on run and weather conditions.
7. You may only ride sitting down on the tubes. Tubes are not to be stacked for rides.
8. Tubing is only permitted on designated tube runs which have been prepared for your safety. Modifying runs is not permissible.
9. No throwing snow into the tube runs or at people coming down runs.
10. Tubes are to be obtained outside the barn and returned to that location when finished. Tubes should be turned over when left outside.
11. You are tubing at your own risk. Be careful; do not act foolishly.

Those individuals who choose not to follow these rules or are found deliberately ramming or interfering with other tubers will not be allowed to continue tubing.
